Building safety update: Change to the fire evacuation plan for Burgundy House

Thank you for your help with the installation of the new heat detectors. The work is now complete in your block. Team East Village (EVM) will be activating the new integrated wireless fire alarm system in your building on Friday 09 April 2021 at 7pm.

This means we can end the 24/7 fire safety patrol service. As of this date and time there will be a change to the evacuation plan for your building. The full details of this evacuation plan can be found on the attached Fire Safety Guide.

Please note, in the unlikely event of a fire:

- If you hear the sounders in your apartment activate, please do not ignore it
- Stop what you are doing immediately and leave your home, closing all doors or windows on your way out where you can
- You should evacuate via the protected stairwell, leaving the building and heading to the evacuation point at the corner of Liberty Bridge Road and Leyton Road (pictured below):



Team East Village will coordinate with the London Fire Brigade. Once the all clear has been given by the London Fire Brigade, you will be able to return to your building.

If you haven't already, please let your landlord know if for any reason you would not be able to evacuate without assistance in the event of an emergency.

We would also like to take this opportunity to reassure you that the current procedures we have put in place are to protect you in the unlikely event of a fire.
